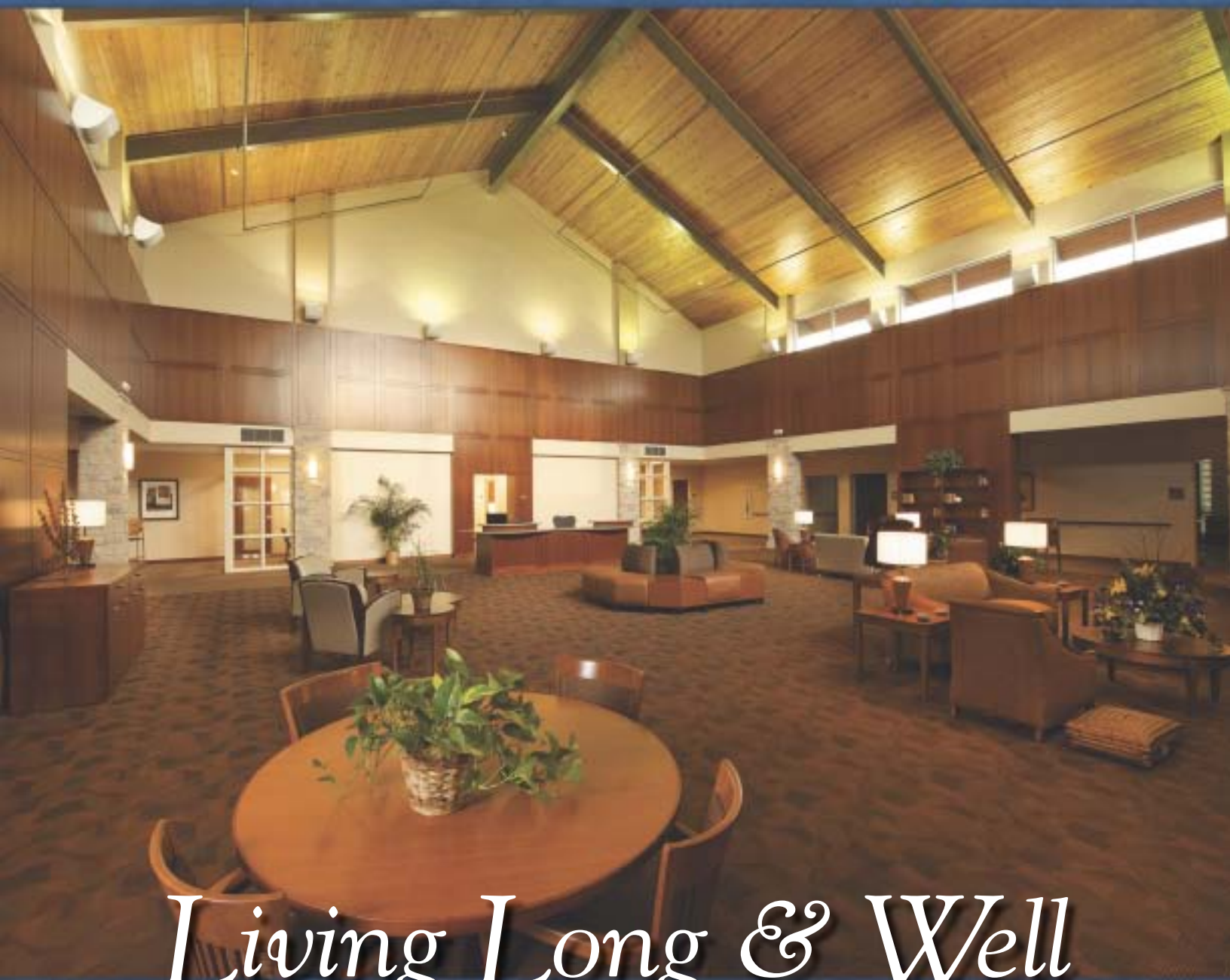

Two years ago, the parents of three-year-old cancer patient Mariah Klein sought out Kim Thornborrow, a successfully commissioned artist working with children diagnosed with cancer, in hopes of her hosting a benefit for their daughter.

Thornborrow had Mariah paint two canvases, one to be auctioned for benefit funds, and the other to be given to Mariah's family as a keepsake.

Inspired by her work with Mariah, Thornborrow created Helping Elevate thru Art & Love (HEAL), meant to help anyone with special needs through art and/or pet therapy. "The whole thing is divine intervention," says Thornborrow. "It warms your heart."

Maddy West, of Appleton, was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia in August 2006 when she was 21 months old. She is one of the many people benefiting from HEAL.

"I felt so happy while I was painting," Maddy expresses.

Having finished chemotherapy in December 2008, Maddy, now almost six years old, knows the impact that her painting will have on others.

"It's important that I painted because one of my paintings will help other sick kids," she says.

The ARTgarage in Green Bay will join HEAL for the Celebrate Life Art Show on September 30 from 4-8pm. Paintings created by young cancer patients and survivors who have undergone HEAL art therapy will be featured in this benefit. The benefit will be open to the general public and artwork may be purchased from September 3 through the time of the show on September 30.
