- 1) Interested party can call or email to reserve their artwork, or other items like Mommy Vases and Jewelry Keepers. To reserve by phone call Carrie with HEAL at 920-737-6950, or call Colleen in Child Life at 920-433-8915. To email: send to healart@gmail.com with subject line of the name of piece interested in purchasing (*i.e., Jessica's Peace, Vases, Jewelry Keepers*).
- 2) Artwork is available on first come, first serve basis. Payment is appreciated within the week of reserving your purchase. If payment is not received, and there is another interested buyer on the waiting list, we will notify the next buyer of the opportunity to purchase.
- 3) A minimum donation purchase price has been established by size of piece.
- 4) Artwork must be on display up until the Artist Reception on **Thursday, September 30**.
- 5) Purchasers should make arrangements to pick up their artwork at the ARTgarage during the Artist Reception on Thursday, September 30.
- 6) Out of town purchases are accepted. *Shipping costs to be paid by the Buyer, unless arrangements can be made. Shipping costs will vary based on size of canvas. Vases and Keepers can be shipped if requested, please allow \$10 for packing and shipping the glass.*
- 7) Payment is appreciated at time of pre-sale purchase. Please make payments payable to: HEAL, Inc. Payments can be mailed to: HEAL, PO Box 5644, De Pere, WI 54115. HEAL will accept cash and check payments. We do accept payment via PayPal, which can be made on www.healart.org, **but please confirm artwork before making any payments!** Your donation is tax-deductible! *Cash payments should be made in-person to Colleen or Carrie.*
